How to load the RSA Shoprite Coordinates onto your Garmin navigation device.

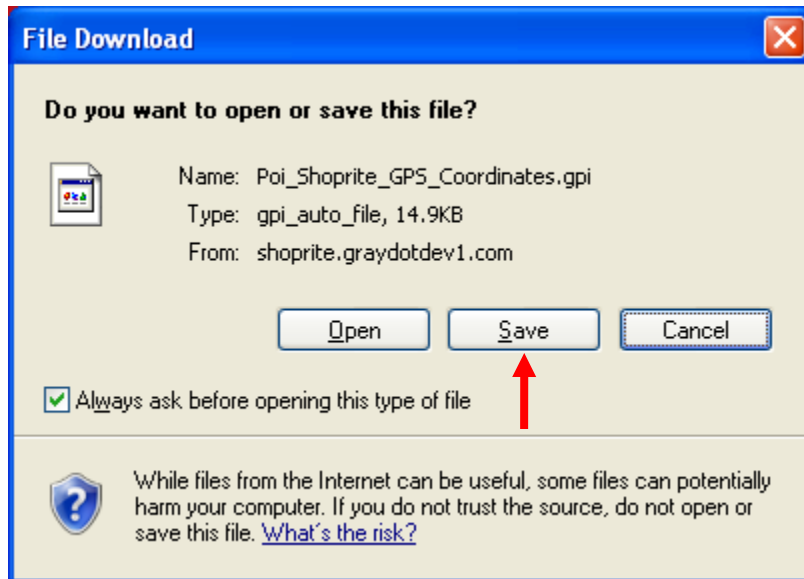
Step 1:

Click on the “click here” instruction on the Shoprite Store Finder web page.

Step 2:

The **File Download** window will appear immediately. Click on the “SAVE” option and save the Poi_Shoprite_GPS_Coordinates.gpi file onto your computer. For example, you can save the file under My Documents or on your Desktop



Step 3:

Connect your GPS device to your computer. Copy the saved Poi_Shoprite_GPS_Coordinates.gpi file into the **POI folder** on your Garmin.
