### How to load the RSA Checkers Coordinates onto your Garmin navigation device.

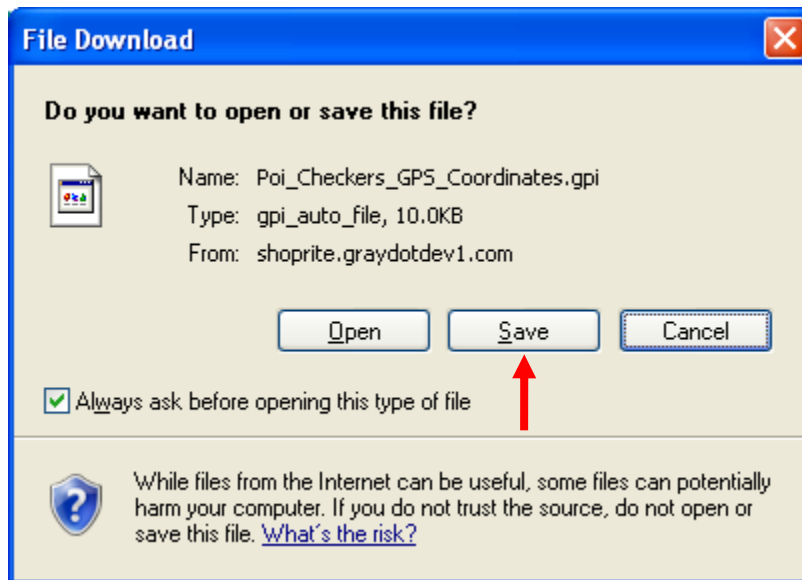
#### Step 1:

Click on the “click here” instruction on the Checkers Store Locator web page.

## Step 2:

The **File Download** window will appear immediately. Click on the “SAVE” option and save the Poi\_Checkers\_GPS\_Coordinates.gpi file onto your computer. For example, you can save the file under My Documents or on your Desktop



## Step 3:

Connect your GPS device to your computer. Copy the saved Poi\_Checkers\_GPS\_Coordinates.gpi file into the **POI folder** on your Garmin.
